

From large science centres to small stematoriums

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Hong Kong has just one ASPAC member in the territory. But when talking about STEM learning for venues open to the public with permanent exhibits, there are over 30. Many of them are called education / resources centres whilst some are uniquely named. What should be the relationship between them?

Although most of the STEM-learning venues in HK are small, some such as the Ocean Park are big. Whatsoever their size, they face the same issues: performance pledges in visitor number and value for money. With experience of working in both big and small centres, CK will discuss the differences between the two, and how ASPAC could address their diversified needs.
